

### High-Speed 8051 $\mu$ C Core

- Pipelined instruction architecture; executes 70% of instructions in 1 or 2 system clocks
- Up to 25 MIPS throughput with 25 MHz system clock

### User Programmable Timing Functions

- Four general purpose 16-bit counter/timers

- Real-time clock mode using enhanced timer and crystal

### Clock Sources

- Calibrated Internal programmable oscillator
  - Calibrated to 2% accuracy over temp and V<sub>DD</sub>
  - 24.5 MHz to allow max speed CPU operation
  - Supports crystal-less UART operation
- External oscillator: RC, C, or Clock
- Can switch between clock sources on-the-fly
